Galatians 2:4~ But because of the false brothers brought in quietly, who sneaked in to spy upon our freedom, which we have in union with Christ Jesus, that they might completely enslave us.

1. However Paul relates about false brothers who were quietly brought in to sneak on their freedom, which they have in union with Christ. Their true object was to enslave them, to their own teachings.

[Question] What were false teachers coming into the congregation, trying to accomplish within it?

2. Hear the word of Yehowah, you men who are trembling at his word; Your brothers that are hating you, that are excluding you by reason of my name, said; May Yehowah be glorified! He must also appear with rejoicing on your part, and they are the ones, that will be put to shame. (Isaiah 66:5)

[Question] What did some do who claimed to worship God toward their own brothers?

[Question] Yet who would Yehowah appear to with rejoicing on their parts?

3. Since we have heard, that some from among us have caused you trouble with speeches, trying to subvert your souls, although we did not give them any instructions.

(Acts of Apostles 15:24)

[Question] What had some of the Jewish Christians done in Antioch, and why did they do so?

4. In journeys often, in dangers from rivers, in dangers from highwaymen, in dangers from my own race, in dangers from the nations, in dangers in the city, in dangers in the wilderness, in dangers at sea, in dangers among false brothers. (2 Corinthians 11:26)

[Question] What things did Paul experience throughout his ministry?[Question] What was especially hard to bear?

5. My reason, is that certain men have slipped in, who have long ago been appointed by the Scriptures to this judgment, ungodly men, turning the undeserved kindness

of our God, into an excuse for loose conduct, and proving false to our only Owner and Lord, Jesus Christ. (Jude 1:4)

[Question] Who eventually slipped into the anointed congregation, and what did they turn God's undeserved kindness into, and who did they prove false toward?

6. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (John 8:32)

[Question] What will anointed Christians always know through the spirit, and what will it set them free from?

7. Therefore if the Son sets you free, you will be actually free. (John 8:36)

[Question] What kind of freedom did Jesus really give men?

8. Now Yehowah is the Spirit, and where the spirit of Yehowah is, there is freedom. (2 Corinthians 3:17)

[Question] What accompanies the spirit of Yehowah God toward all who possess it?

9. For such freedom Christ set us free. Therefore stand fast, and do not let yourselves be confined again in a yoke of slavery. (Galatians 5:1)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ set us free for?

[Question] What then, should we not allow ourselves to be enslaved by?

10" Be as free people, and yet holding your freedom, not as a blind for badness, but as slaves of God. (1 Peter 2:16)

[Question] How should anointed Christians use their freedoms, before God and Christ Jesus?

11. In fact, you put up with whoever enslaves you, whoever devours what you have, whoever grabs what you have, whoever exalts himself over you, whoever strikes you in the face. (2 Corinthians 11:20)

[Question] What did the Corinthians allow others to do towards them, when they should have been more discerning?

12. But now that you have come to know God, or rather now

that you have come to be known by God, how is it that you are turning back again to the weak and beggarly elementary things and want to slave for them over again? (Galatians 4:9)

[Question] What does the spirit cause one to know intimately?

[Question] What should persons under the influence of the Holy Spirit, never return to doing?

13. Like foxes in the devastated places are what your own prophets have become, O Israel. (Ezekiel 13:4)

[Question] What did false prophets in Israel become likened to, when Yehowah God closed off approach to himself, to them?

14. What then? Nothing, except that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is being publicized, and in this, I rejoice. In fact, I will also keep on rejoicing. (Philippians 1:18)

[Question] What did Paul always rejoice, that was being publicized through his efforts?
