Galatians 2:6~ But on the part of those who seemed to be something, whatever sort of men they formerly were makes no difference to me, God¹ does not go by a man's outward appearance, to me, in fact, those outstanding men imparted nothing new.

1. Paul now shows, that those outstanding men of the apostles, imparted nothing new to the Good News he was already preaching, and so they were all unified in their teachings, which was what Paul wanted. Paul did not judge by a man's outward appearance, and he did not care, that the apostles were men who were unlettered and ordinary, as viewed by most of the Pharisees, of which Paul had once been one also.

[Question] When Paul visited the apostles, and told them of what he was preaching, what did they add to it?

Yes, when they came to know the undeserved kindness that was given me, James and Cephas and John, the ones who seemed to be pillars, gave me and Barnabas the right hand of sharing together, that we should go to the nations, but they to those who are circumcised. (Galatians 2:9)

[Question] What sharing did the other apostles give to Paul and Barnabus, after speaking at length about their ministry?

3. But when I saw they were not walking straight according to the truth of the Good News, I said to Cephas before them all; If you, though you are a Jew, live as the nations do, and not as Jews do, how is it that you are compelling people of the nations to live according to Jewish practice? (Galatians 2:14)

[Question] Why did Peter stand condemned, for his partiality expressed to the Jews alone?

4 For Yehowah your God is the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the God great, mighty and fear-inspiring, who treats none with partiality nor accepts a bribe. (Deuteronomy 10:17)

[Question] What does the great God Yehowah never express to any man?

5. At this Peter opened his mouth and said; For a certainty, I

perceive that God is not partial. (Acts of Apostles 10:34)

[Question] What did Peter himself say about this same God?

6 For there is no partiality with God. (Romans 2:11)

[Question] What is there none of with God?

7. There is One who has not shown partiality to princes, and has not given more consideration to the noble one than to the lowly one, for all of them are the work of his hands. (Job 34:19)

[Question] What was Yehowah as a judge known for?

8' We are fools because of Christ, but you are discreet in Christ. We are weak, but you are strong. You are in good repute, but we are in dishonor. (1 Corinthians 4:10)

[Question] How did Paul and the other apostles stand, in the view of others?

9. For I consider that I have not in a single thing proved inferior to your superfine apostles. (2 Corinthians 11:5)

[Question] What did Paul himself not become inferior to in a single point?
