

Galatians 2:7~ But, on the contrary, when they saw, that I had entrusted to me the Good News for those who are uncircumcised,¹ just as Peter had it for those who are circumcised.²

Footnote: Literally, of the uncircumcision

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- 1• On the contrary, for when they saw, that Paul had the same Good News, that had been entrusted to them to preach to the Jews, but for him to go to the nations.

[Question] What did they realize, about the Good News, Paul was then preaching?

- 2• But, **just** as we have been proved by God as fit to be **entrusted** with the **Good News**, so we speak, as pleasing, not men, but God, who makes proof of our hearts. (**1 Thessalonians 2:4**)

[Question] Who had originally seen Paul as a fit vessel to contain the Good News for the nations?

[Question] Who then, did Paul always try to please through his ministry?

- 3• And yet he said to me; Get on your way, because I shall send you out to nations far off. (**Acts of Apostles 22:21**)

[Question] Where did the Christ send Paul off to, to preach the Good News of God?

- 4• Now I speak to you who are people of the nations. Forasmuch as I am, in reality, an apostle to the nations, I glorify my ministry. (**Romans 11:13**)

[Question] Who was Paul appointed to become an apostle to?

- 5• For the purpose of this witness I was appointed a preacher and an apostle, I am telling the truth, I am not lying, a teacher of nations in the matter of faith and truth. (**1 Timothy 2:7**)

[Question] What work was the apostle Paul appointed to by God and Christ?

- 6• When the apostles in Jerusalem heard, that Samaria had

accepted the word of God, they dispatched **Peter** and John to them. (**Acts of Apostles 8:14**)

[Question] Who did the apostles dispatch to Samaria, when they first heard of their conversion?

- 7· But the Lord said to him; Be on your way, because this man is a chosen vessel to me, to bear my name to the nations, as well as to kings and the sons of Israel. (**Acts of Apostles 9:15**)

[Question] What was Paul appointed as a chosen vessel to do?

- 8· Through whom we received undeserved kindness and an apostleship, in order, that there might be obedience of faith among all the nations, respecting his name. (**Romans 1:5**)

[Question] What was the purpose of Paul's apostleship?

- 9· For me to be a public servant of Christ Jesus to the nations, engaging in the holy work of the Good News of God, in order, that the offering, namely, these nations, might prove to be acceptable, it being sanctified with Holy Spirit. (**Romans 15:16**)

[Question] What was Paul's purpose in preaching to the nations?

- 10· If I perform this willingly, I have a reward, but if I do it against my will, all the same, I have a stewardship **entrusted** to me. (**1 Corinthians 9:17**)

[Question] What stewardship to preach did Paul receive from Christ Jesus?

- 11· According to the glorious Good News of the happy God, with which I was **entrusted**. (**1 Timothy 1:11**)

[Question] What is Yehowah God called?

- 12· This fine trust guard through the Holy Spirit which is dwelling in us. (**2 Timothy 1:14**)

[Question] How could anointed Christians guard the trust of God within them?
