Galatians 2:8~ For He who gave Peter powers necessary for an apostleship to those who are circumcised, gave powers also to me for those who are of the nations;

1. For Paul shows, that the one who gave powers necessary for an apostleship to Peter, also is the one who gave Paul his powers, as proof of his apostleship, as a sent forth one.

[Question] What powers of an apostle was Paul given, like the other apostles?

2. But the Lord said to him; Be on your way, because this man is a chosen vessel to me, to bear my name to the nations, as well as to kings and the sons of Israel. (Acts of Apostles 9:15)

[Question] What was Ananias told about Paul at his conversion to Christianity?

3. Through whom we received undeserved kindness and an apostleship, in order, that there might be obedience of faith among all the nations, respecting his name. (Romans 1:5)

[Question] What was the purpose, of God's extending undeserved kindness and mercy to Paul?

4. To this end I am indeed working hard, exerting myself in accordance with the operation of him, and which is at work in me with power. (Colossians 1:29)

[Question] How did Paul himself respond to the undeserved kindness of God working within him?

5. For me to be a public servant of Christ Jesus to the nations, engaging in the holy work of the Good News of God, in order, that the offering, namely, these nations, might prove to be acceptable, it being sanctified with Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:16)

[Question] Why did Paul engage in the holy work of preaching the Good News of God's Kingdom?

6. For our part we will boast, not outside our assigned boundaries, but according to the boundary of the territory that God apportioned to us by measure, making it reach

even as far as you. (2 Corinthians 10:13)

[Question] Where did Paul try to focus his ministry, so as not to preach in another's territory?

7. For the purpose of this witness I was appointed a preacher and an apostle, I am telling the truth, I am not lying, a teacher of nations in the matter of faith and truth. (1 Timothy 2:7)

[Question] For what purpose was Paul appointed as an apostle?
