Galatians 3:16~ Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. It says, not. And to seeds, as in the case of many such, but as in the case of one. And to your seed, who is Christ.

Footnote: Or, He

1. Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. As Paul duly notes, it does not mean as to seeds as in the plural, but in the singular, one seed.

[Question] What seed was the Abrahamic covenant pointing to, the covenant of (Genesis 17:1-14)?

2. Paul then identifies that seed, as being Christ, the Greater than Isaac, the heir of the second covenant to Abraham, a covenant to time indefinite, which imparts true righteousness, and which Abraham put faith in, by having relations with Sarah and then waiting patiently for the seed to arrive according to Yehowah's spoken word to Abraham.

[Question] Who does Paul identify, as that one seed?

[Question] How did Abraham put faith in this covenant, before receiving the promised seed?

[Question] What did he then do toward that seed, per the agreement of the covenant to circumcise his offspring?

3. In the interim he and all his household got circumcised to seal this covenant, and so the circumcision is the seal of the New Covenant, the Abrahamic covenant, and is still in effect and mandatory for all Christians. However, Paul came to just the opposite conclusion.

[Question] What did Abraham do immediately in faith in this covenant, before the arrival of the true seed?

[Question] What covenant then, is still in effect, and what then, is still binding upon all true Christians through it?

4. And Yehowah proceeded to say to Abram; Go your way out of your country and from your relatives and from the house of your father, to the country that I shall show you. (Genesis 12:1)

[Question] What was Abraham told to did to follow the will of Yehowah God?

5' Yehowah now appeared to Abram and said; To your seed I am going to give this land. After that, he built an altar there to Yehowah, who had appeared to him. (Genesis 12:7)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to give to him?

6 Because all the land at which you are looking, to you and to your seed I am going to give it until time indefinite. (Genesis 13:15)

[Question] Who did Yehowah God promise to give all the land before Abraham to, and for how long a time?

7. And I will carry out my covenant between me and you and your seed after you, according to their generations for a covenant to time indefinite, to prove myself God to you and to your seed after you. (Genesis 17:7)

[Question] To whom would Yehowah then carry out his covenant toward, and for how long?

8' Yehowah the God of the heavens, who took me from my father's house and from the land of my relatives and who spoke to me and who swore to me, saying; To your seed I am going to give this land, he will send his angel ahead of you, and you will certainly take a wife for my son from there. (Genesis 24:7)

[Question] Where was Abraham told to get a wife for his son?

9. And there will still be in it a tenth, and it must again become something for burning down, like a big tree and like a massive tree in which, when there is a cutting down of them, there is a stump, a holy seed will be the stump of it. (Isaiah 6:13)

[Question] What did Isaiah prophesy, about the holy seed, that would remain within Israel?

10" Moreover, if you belong to Christ, you are really Abraham's seed, heirs with reference to a promise. (Galatians 3:29)

[Question] What are all those, who belong to Christ?

[Question] Therefore does the covenant of (Genesis 17:1-14) apply to anointed Christians today?

11: Later on Abraham gave everything he had to Isaac. (Genesis 25:5)

[Question] Who became the sole heir of Abraham in the flesh, and what did this point to spiritually?

12. Neither because they are Abraham's seed are they all children, but; What will be called your seed, will be through Isaac. (Romans 9:7)

[Question] Are all the Jews the seed of Abraham, just because of the flesh?

[Question] What seed is referenced, and who do they come through?

[Question] Who is the Greater than Isaac?

13. That is, the children in the flesh are not really the children of God, but the children by the promise are counted as the seed. (Romans 9:8)

[Question] Who then, are the seed, and how do they come forth through what?

14. And by means of your seed all nations of the earth will certainly bless themselves, due to the fact, that you have listened to my voice. (Genesis 22:18)

[Question] By means of whom, will all the nations of the earth bless themselves, and why?

15. The scepter will not turn aside from Judah, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to him the obedience of the peoples will belong. (Genesis 49:10)

[Question] How long would the scepter of the kingship remain in Judah?

[Question] Where then, would it fall to, and what would belong to Shiloh?

16. All the generations, then, from Abraham until David were fourteen generations, and from David until the deportation to Babylon fourteen generations, and from the deportation to Babylon until the Christ fourteen generations. (Matthew 1:17)

[Question] What three divisions are made of fourteen generations in the ancestry of Christ?

17. And I shall put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)

[Question] What would always exist between the seed of the serpent, and the true seed of the woman?

[Ouestion] What would the true seed do to Satan the Devil?

[Question] What would Satan the Devil do to the woman?

18. And Terah lived on for seventy years, after which he became father to Abram, Nahor and Haran. (Genesis 11:26)

[Question] Which children did Terah have?

19. As for the land that I have given to Abraham and to Isaac, to you I shall give it, and to your seed after you I shall give the land. (Genesis 35:12)

[Question] What further promise was made to Jacob?

20" Just as he told to our forefathers, to Abraham and to his seed, forever. (Luke 1:55)

[Question] Who was the promise given to, and for how long?

21. But the man who did not trace his genealogy from them took tithes from Abraham and blessed him who had the promises. (Hebrews 7:6)

[Question] Who blessed Abraham and took tithes from him?
