

Galatians 3:23~ However, before the faith arrived, we were being guarded under Law, being delivered up together into custody, looking to the faith that was destined to be revealed.

- 1· Now Paul speaks of himself and others who are Jews, that they have been being guarded while under Law, the Law Covenant acting like a constable, condemning their conduct and taking them into his custody. However, during this time they were still looking forward in faith to things that were promised, but not yet fully revealed.

[Question] How were the Israelites being guarded by the Law Covenant they lived under?

[Question] How though, during all this time, should they have been looking ahead, to what fine promises of God?

- 2· But when the full limit of the time **arrived**, God sent forth his Son, who came to be out of a woman, and who came to be **under Law**. (**Galatians 4:4**)

[Question] What then happened, at the full limit of the appointed times?

- 3· And blotted out the handwritten document against us, which consisted of decrees, and which was in opposition to us, and He has taken it out of the way by nailing it to the torture stake. (**Colossians 2:14**)

[Question] How did Yehowah God take away and blot out the handwritten document of the Law Covenant from his faithful people?

- 4· For Christ is the end of the Law, so that everyone exercising **faith** may have righteousness. (**Romans 10:4**)

[Question] What do all those exercising faith receive from Yehowah God?
