- 1· Now since we are all in the classroom and being taught by the Great Teacher, the tutor goes away to his home, for he is no longer needed. We love what we are learning through the spirit and we are making real progress in living a life under God's approval.

[Question] What does the tutor go away to, once the children are in the classroom?

[Question] What love of learning will now guide us to know Yehowah?

- 2· For those things are a shadow of the things to come, but the reality belongs to the Christ. (**Colossians 2:17**)

[Question] What was the Law Covenant a shadow of, but to whom does the reality of it belong?

- 3· But they have heard it rumored about you, that you have been teaching all the Jews among the nations, an apostasy from Moses, telling them neither to circumcise their children, nor to walk in the solemn customs. (**Acts of Apostles 21:21**)

[Question] Why did Paul needlessly experience greater trouble with the Jews in the **First Century C.E.**?

- 4· But now Jesus **has** obtained a more excellent public service, so that he is also the mediator of a correspondingly better covenant, which **has** been legally established upon better promises. (**Hebrews 8:6**)

[Question] What has Jesus Christ obtained, and so what is he the mediator of?

- 5· For since the Law **has** a shadow of the good things to come, but not the very substance of the things, men can never, with the same sacrifices from year to year which they offer continually, make those who approach perfect. (**Hebrews 10:1**)

[Question] What does the Law Covenant contain, and what does it like a shadow lack?

[Question] Why did the men under the Law Covenant have to offer sacrifices repeatedly from year to year?
