Galatians 3:4~ Did you undergo so many sufferings to no purpose? If it really was to no purpose.

1 Paul now asks; Why did you undergo so many sufferings, was it for no purpose? For Christians are suffering as they put to death the desires of the fallen flesh by means of their own love of the Holy Spirit within them, through spirit anointing. Has this process stopped in them, and now is it no longer needed? Did they start out on this course, without purpose?

[Question] What is the course that all anointed Christians must walk in, throughout their lives on earth?

[Question] What question does Paul now ask, showing what?

2. For you have need of endurance, in order, that, after you have done the will of God, you may receive the fulfillment of the promise. (Hebrews 10:36)

[Question] What do anointed Christians need to reach their goals in the race for eternal life?

3. Look out for yourselves, that you do not lose the things we have worked to produce, but that you may obtain a full reward. (2 John 1:8)

[Question] What should they ever be wary about in this race, and why?

4. Through which you are also being saved, with the speech with which I declared the Good News to you, if you are holding it fast, unless, in fact, you became believers to no purpose. (1 Corinthians 15:2)

[Question] What would be the point of starting out in this race, and then just falling out of contention?
