

Galatians 3:5~ He, therefore, who supplies you the spirit and performs powerful works¹ among you, does he do it owing to works of Law, or owing to a hearing by faith?

Footnote: Or, performs miracles

- 1• Now Paul asks about Yehowah God, who supplies them with his Holy Spirit, and who through it performs powerful works among them, does this spirit come forth to them through works of Law, or due to a hearing by faith.

[Question] What question does Paul now ask them, about how they came to possess the Holy Spirit in their lives?

- 2• While Peter was yet speaking about these matters the Holy Spirit fell upon all those **hearing** the word. (**Acts of Apostles 10:44**)

[Question] What fell upon Cornelius, and those with him, when Peter spoke the Good News to them?

- 3• To yet another operations of **powerful works**, to another prophesying, to another discernment of inspired utterances, to another different tongues, and to another interpretation of tongues. (**1 Corinthians 12:10**)

[Question] What gifts does the Holy Spirit confer upon anointed ones?

- 4• And God has set the respective ones in the congregation, first, apostles, second, prophets, third, teachers, then **powerful works**, then gifts of healings, helpful services, abilities to direct, different tongues. (**1 Corinthians 12:28**)

[Question] What order of importance, do these gifts carry?

- 5• Why should not the administering of the **spirit** be much more with glory? (**2 Corinthians 3:8**)

[Question] What would be far more glorious, than the giving of the Law Covenant was?

- 6• For it is impossible as regards those who have once for all been enlightened, and who have tasted the heavenly free gift, and **who have become partakers of Holy Spirit**. (**Hebrews 6:4**)

[Question] What is it impossible for those who have tasted of the spirit, but have fallen away to revive again in this lives?
