Galatians 3:6~ Just as Abraham put faith in Yehowah, and it was counted to him as righteousness.

1. Paul now refers back to the Abrahamic covenant of (Genesis 15:1-20), which prefigures the Law Covenant itself, showing that Abraham put faith in this covenant, and his faith was counted to him as righteousness.

[Question] What covenant does Paul now refer to, and what was counted to Abraham due to his faith in this covenant?

[Question] What form of imputed righteousness then does this reference, that later came to the Jews under the Law Covenant?

2. And he put faith in Yehowah, and he proceeded to count it to him as righteousness. (Genesis 15:6)

[Question] What did Yehowah God count to Abraham for his faith in this covenant, made over sacrificial victims?

3. For what does the scripture say? Abraham exercised faith in Yehowah, and it was counted to him as righteousness. (Romans 4:3)

[Question] What do the scriptures say, about what God counted to Abraham, and why?

4. And the scripture was fulfilled which says; Abraham put faith in Yehowah, and it was counted to him as righteousness, and he came to be called, Yehowah's friend. (James 2:23)

[Question] What did Abraham come to be called after putting faith in God's promises?
