

**Galatians 3:8~**

**Now the Scripture, seeing in advance that God would declare people of the nations righteous due to faith, declared the Good News beforehand to Abraham, namely; **By means of you all the nations will be blessed.****

- 1· So then the Scripture, seeing the future in advance, showed, that Yehowah God would declare people righteous due to faith, and so the first foregleams of the Good News were declared to righteous Abraham, when God said; **By means of you, all the nations will be blessed.**

**[Question]** What did the Scripture declare to Abraham that applies to people of the nations?

**[Question]** What was said to Abraham denoting this?

- 2· And I **will** bless those who bless you, and him that calls down evil upon you I shall curse, and all the families of the ground **will** certainly bless themselves by **means** of you. (**Genesis 12:3**)

**[Question]** Who then, would bless themselves by means of Abraham?

- 3· Why, **Abraham** is surely going to become a nation great and mighty, and all the **nations** of the earth must bless themselves by **means** of him. (**Genesis 18:18**)

**[Question]** Who did Yehowah state would bless themselves due to Abraham?

- 4· You are the sons of the prophets and of the covenant which **God** covenanted with your forefathers, saying to **Abraham**; And in your seed all the families of the earth **will** be blessed. (**Acts of Apostles 3:25**)

**[Question]** In whom would all the families of the earth be blessed?

- 5· And by **means** of your seed all **nations** of the earth **will** certainly bless themselves, **due** to the fact, that you have listened to my voice. (**Genesis 22:18**)

**[Question]** Why would all the nations of the earth be blessed through Abraham?

- 6· And I **will** multiply your seed like the stars of the heavens and I **will** give to your seed all these lands, and by **means**

of your seed all **nations** of the earth **will** certainly bless themselves. (**Genesis 26:4**)

**[Question]** What would the seed of Abraham be multiplied like, and what lands would Yehowah give to them?

- 7· How comely upon the mountains are the feet of the one bringing **Good News**, the one publishing peace, the one bringing Good News of something better, the one publishing salvation, the one saying to Zion; Your **God** has become king! (**Isaiah 52:7**)

**[Question]** What does Isaiah say about the one publishing the Good News, that God's Kingdom has come?

- 8· And it must occur that you should allot it for inheritance to yourselves and to the alien residents who are residing as aliens in your midst, who have become father to sons in the midst of you. And they must become to you like a native among the sons of Israel. With you **people** they **will** fall by lot into an inheritance in the midst of the tribes of Israel. (**Ezekiel 47:22**)

**[Question]** Who was included in the inheritance of Israel, in the vision of Ezekiel?

- 9· And many **peoples** and mighty **nations will** actually come to seek Yehowah of armies in Jerusalem and to soften the face of Yehowah. (**Zechariah 8:22**)

**[Question]** Who did Zechariah show would come to worship before Yehowah God?

- 10· Paul, a slave of Jesus Christ and called to be an apostle, separated to God's **Good News**. (**Romans 1:1**)

**[Question]** What work was the Apostle Paul separated to?

- 11· If truly **God** is one, who **will declare** circumcised **people righteous** as a result of **faith** and uncircumcised **people righteous** by **means** of their **faith**. (**Romans 3:30**)

**[Question]** What had Yehowah God done to both circumcised and uncircumcised people, through their faith?
