Galatians 3:9~ Consequently those who adhere to faith are being blessed together with faithful Abraham.

Footnote: Or, believing

1. Consequently, those, who like Abraham, adhere to faith, are being blessed, together with faithful Abraham, and that includes Christians, who can receive the New Covenant through their faith, just like that of Abraham's.

[Question] Who then, are being blessed, and upon what basis?

2. Remember those who are taking the lead among you, who have spoken the word of God to you, and as you contemplate how their conduct turns out, imitate their faith. (Hebrews 13:7)

[Question] What should we all imitate about Christian elders?

3. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor freeman, there is neither male nor female. For you are all one person in union with Christ Jesus. (Galatians 3:28)

[Question] What distinctions simply disappear within Christianity?

4 Moreover, if you belong to Christ, you are really Abraham's seed, heirs with reference to a promise. (Galatians 3:29)

[Question] Who are really Abraham's seed, heirs with reference to a promise?

5. For he is really not assisting angels at all, but he is assisting Abraham's seed. (Hebrews 2:16)

**[Question]** Who is the Christ assisting to become heirs?

6. Now Abraham was old, advanced in years, and Yehowah had blessed Abraham in everything. (Genesis 24:1)

[Question] What is said of Abraham in his later years?

7. But he went on to say; Your brother came with deception, that he might get the blessing meant for you. (Genesis 27:35)

[Question] What did Jacob do to gain the blessing of the birthright, which he valued greatly?

- 8. But because of the promise of God, he did not waver in a lack of faith, but became powerful by his faith, giving God glory (Romans 4:20)
  - [Question] How did Abraham become after hearing in faith the promise of Yehowah God?
- 9. Besides, in this case, what is looked for in stewards is for a man to be found faithful. (1 Corinthians 4:2)
  - [Question] What quality is looked for in those serving as stewards?
