Galatians 4:1~ Now I say that as long as the heir is a babe, he does not differ at all from a slave, lord of all things though he is.

1. Now Paul shows, that as long as the heir is a babe, he does not differ very markedly from a slave's son, even though he is going to inherit greater things later in life. Yet as he grows nearer to gaining his inheritance, then he matures and gains responsibility and knowledge.

[Question] What must the son gain before becoming eligible for his inheritance?

2. And he went down with them and came to Nazareth, and he continued subject to them. Also, his mother carefully kept all these sayings in her heart. (Luke 2:51)
