Footnote: Or, appointed times Greek, *kai-rous*'

1· They had turned back to scrupulously observing days and months and years, and festal seasons. Was this not done away with when the Law Covenant passed out of existence for them, when they were bought out from under it?

[Question] What were they still doing, that made Paul wonder, if they got the point of his teachings?

2· One man judges one day as above another, another man judges one day as all others, let each man be fully convinced in his own mind. (Romans 14:5)

[Question] What do anointed Christians have the freedom to do, or not to do?

3· Therefore let no man judge you in eating and drinking or in respect of a festival or of an observance of the new moon or of a Sabbath. (Colossians 2:16)

[Question] Why should one man not judge another, in the doing of what?
