

Galatians 4:11~ I fear for you, that somehow I have toiled to no purpose respecting you.

- 1· Paul was beginning to wonder if his preaching among them had been to no purpose. Did they not understand the things, that they had been taught?

[Question] What was Paul beginning to wonder about them in Galatia?

- 2· But I went up as a result of a revelation. And I laid before them the Good News which I am preaching among the nations, privately, however, before those who were outstanding men, for fear that **somehow** I was running or had run in vain. (**Galatians 2:2**)

[Question] What Good News did Paul himself present to the elders in Jerusalem to make sure that it was the right Good News, and in harmony with what others were preaching?

- 3· You are parted from Christ, whoever you are that try to be declared righteous by means of Law. You **have** fallen away from his undeserved kindness. (**Galatians 5:4**)

[Question] What is one parted from, who tries to be declared righteous through works of Law?

- 4· That is why, indeed, when I could bear it no longer, I sent to know of your faithfulness, as perhaps in some way, the Tempter might **have** tempted you, and our labor might **have** turned out to be in vain. (**1 Thessalonians 3:5**)
