

**Galatians 4:13~ But you know, that it was through a sickness of my flesh, I declared the Good News to you the first time.**

- 1• **The Galatians knew, that when Paul had first come to them preaching the Good News of God's Kingdom, he had been very sick. Nonetheless, he still worked in their behalf.**

**[Question]** When Paul first came preaching to them in Galatia, how did he feel?

- 2• **Moreover, they went through Phrygia and the country of Galatia, because they were forbidden by the Holy Spirit to speak the word in the district of Asia. (Acts of Apostles 16:6)**

**[Question]** Why did Paul go through the regions of Phrygia and Galatia, for where was he forbidden to go to through the spirit?

- 3• **And I came to you in weakness, and in fear, and with much trembling. (1 Corinthians 2:3)**

**[Question]** How did Paul present himself to those to whom he preached?

- 4• **For, say they; His letters are weighty and forceful, but his presence in person is weak, and his speech contemptible. (2 Corinthians 10:10)**

**[Question]** What then, did people come to say about his letters, as opposed to his presence in person?

- 5• **Just because of the excess of the revelations. Therefore, that I might not feel overly exalted, there was given me a thorn in the flesh, an angel of Satan, to keep slapping me, that I might not be overly exalted. (2 Corinthians 12:7)**

**[Question]** What did Paul encounter everywhere he went, that helped to keep him humble in God's service?
