

Galatians 4:14~ And what was a trial¹ to you in my flesh, you did not treat with contempt or spit at in disgust, but you received me like an angel of God, like Christ Jesus.

Footnote: Or, temptation Literally, testing

- 1· Even though he was sick then, and did not look very good when before them, they put us with his sickness, and did not spit on him in disgust. Rather, they had received him with respect, and as if he were an angel of God, God's direct messenger.

[Question] How then, did they treat him, even though he was sick, and did not appear pleasing to their eyes?

- 2· So he slandered your servant to my lord the king. But my lord the king is as an angel of the true God, and so, do what is good in your eyes. (2 Samuel 19:27)

[Question] How did Mephibosheth view the king?

- 3· He that receives you receives me also, and he that receives me, receives him also, that sent me forth. (Matthew 10:40)

[Question] What does anyone receiving Christ's disciples receive?

- 4· Most truly I say to you, he that receives anyone I send receives me also. In turn he that receives me, receives also him that sent me. (John 13:20)

[Question] What does anyone receiving Christ receive also?

- 5· At this Achish answered and said to David; I well know that you have been good in my own eyes, like an angel of God. Only it is the princes of the Philistines that have said; Let him not go up with us into the battle. (1 Samuel 29:9)
