

Galatians 4:15~ Where, then, is that happiness you had? For I bear you witness that, if it had been possible, you would have gouged out your eyes and given them to me.

- 1· Paul now asks them; What has happened to that first happiness, that they expressed upon becoming sons of God? Paul now states, that they would gladly have gouged out their own eyes and given them to Paul, for evidently his eyes were his sickness, for they were infected somehow.

[Question] What would they have been willing to do for Paul then, even though he was very sick?

- 2· Nevertheless, I hold this against you, that you **have** left the love you had at first. (**Revelation 2:4**)

[Question] What did the Christ say in condemnatory counsel to the congregations in Revelation?

- 3· See with what large letters I **have** written you with my own hand. (**Galatians 6:11**)

[Question] What was the reason why Paul had to write in such large letters, even though paper was very expensive then?
