Galatians 4:16~ Well, then, have I become your enemy, because I tell you the truth?

1. Paul now asks them; Well now have I become your enemy, because I tell you the truth? That should never be the situation with Christians. We are Christians and followers of Christ, because we love the truth, and the truth has made us free from the enslavements of Satan the Devil's world, which is alienated from God and his way. We should always be open to reasoning about truth.

[Question] Paul now ask, what then has changed?

[Question] What should anointed Christians always be open to reasoning about among themselves?

2. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (John 8:32)

[Question] What will anointed Christians know, and what will it set them free from?

3. Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth listens to my voice. (John 18:37)

[Question] What was the primary purpose of Jesus Christ coming to the earth?

4. The wounds inflicted by a lover are faithful, but the kisses of a hater are things to be entreated. (Proverbs 27:6)

[Question] What are the wounds inflicted by a lover?

5. But they themselves rebelled and made his Holy Spirit feel hurt. He now was changed into an enemy of theirs, he himself warred against them. (Isaiah 63:10)

[Question] What did his people become, when they hurt God's Holy Spirit?

6. For whom Yehowah loves he disciplines. In fact, he scourges every one, whom he receives as a son. (Hebrews

12:6)

[Question] What does Yehowah God do to every son whom he loves?

7. Because I, on the other hand, tell the truth, you do not believe me. (John 8:45)

[Question] What was Jesus speaking to the Jews, and yet what was their response?

8. But speaking the truth, let us by love grow up in all things into him who is the head, Christ. (Ephesians 4:15)

[Question] How can we grow up in love, to the head, who is Christ?

9. And Ahab proceeded to say to Elijah; Have you found me, O enemy of mine? To which he said; I have found you. For the reason that you have sold yourself to do what is bad in the eyes of Yehowah. (1 Kings 21:20)

[Question] How did Ahab come to view Elijah, because his own heart was bad?

10" To these we did not yield by way of submission, no, not for an hour, in order, that the truth of the Good News might continue with you. (Galatians 2:5)

[Question] What did Paul now yield to, because of his love of the truth?
