Galatians 4:18~ However, it is fine for you to be zealously sought for in a fine cause at all times, and not only when I am present with you.

1. Paul now shows, that it is a fine thing for them to be earnestly sought after for a fine cause at all times, and not only when he is present with them.

[Question] How should they be earnestly sought after, at all times?

2. Consequently, my beloved brothers, become steadfast, unmovable, always having plenty to do in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in connection with the Lord. (1 Corinthians 15:58)

[Question] What things should the brothers occupy themselves with, and why?

3. Who gave himself for us that he might deliver us from every sort of lawlessness and cleanse for himself a people peculiarly his own, zealous for fine works. (Titus 2:14)

[Question] Why did the Christ offer himself for anointed ones?

[Question] What kind of people does he want them to become?
