Galatians 4:20~ But I could wish to be present with you just now, and to speak in a different way, because I am perplexed over you.

Footnote: Literally, and to alter my voice

1. Paul wishes, that he could actually be present with them for then he would maybe seeing the situation more clearly, for he is perplexed with the way that they are acting, and would prefer to speak to them in a different way.

[Question] What did Paul now wish could be the case, for how was he feeling about them?

2. Although I have many things to write you, I do not desire to do so with paper and ink, but I am hoping to come to you and to speak with you face to face, that your joy may be in full measure. (2 John 1:12)

[Question] What did John refrain from saying, because he would rather come and speak to them in person?

3. We are pressed in every way, but not cramped beyond movement. We are perplexed, but not absolutely with no way out. (2 Corinthians 4:8)

[Question] What are anointed Christians, many times, in their service to God?

4. Go on carrying the burdens of one another, and thus fulfill the Law of the Christ. (Galatians 6:2)

[Question] What should we go on carrying for one another?

5. But I am hoping to see you directly, and we shall speak face to face. May you have peace. The friends send you their greetings. Give my greetings to the friends by name. (3 John 1:14)

[Question] What did John hope to do, face to face, to those brothers whom he loved?
