

Galatians 4:22~ For example, it is written that Abraham acquired two sons, one by the servant girl and one by the free woman.

- 1· Now he refers to matters preceding the Law Covenant, that happened to Abraham their forefather. This man who is the father of all those having faith, took two wives, one by the servant girl, who was Hagar, and the other the free woman, who was Sarah.

[Question] What matters, does Paul now refer to?

[Question] What two wives did Abraham take for himself, and how were they different?

- 2· Later on Hagar bore to Abram a son and Abram called the name of his son, whom Hagar bore, Ishmael. (**Genesis 16:15**)

[Question] Who was Abraham's firstborn son, and which wife bore him?

- 3· Now Sarai, Abram's wife, had borne him no children, but she had an Egyptian maidservant, and her name was Hagar. (**Genesis 16:1**)

[Question] What was Sarah's condition then?

- 4· Accordingly **Abraham** called the name of his son who had been born to him, whom Sarah had borne to him, Isaac. (**Genesis 21:3**)

[Question] Which son did Sarah later bear according to God's promise?

- 5· And as for the son of the slave **girl**, I shall also constitute him a nation, because he is your offspring. (**Genesis 21:13**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to make the son of the slave girl, Hagar, because he was Abraham's offspring?

- 6· If she is displeasing in the eyes of her master so that he does not designate her as a concubine, but causes her to be redeemed, he will not be entitled to sell her to a foreign people in his treacherously dealing with her. (**Exodus 21:8**)

[Question] What was a later Law in Israel regarding concubines?
