**Galatians 4:26~** But the Jerusalem above is free, and she is our mother.

1. Now Paul shows, that the Jerusalem above, in heaven, is the mother of spirit anointed Christians, for it is free from sin, because it is heavenly, and it never took a course of rebellion to God, like the demon angels did, who thereby enslaved themselves and all mankind along with them.

[Question] Who though, is the spiritual mother of anointed Christians, and so what is her condition relative to sin, and why?

2. Therefore, she is a free woman, who is freely able to enter into a marriage agreement to Yehowah God, and the New Covenant is this marriage agreement between God and those who will marry his firstborn son, Jesus Christ. Christians are therefore the seed of Sarah, God's heavenly angelic organization. They come to life through the spirit of God, like angels do, but while still in fleshly bodies here on earth.

[Question] What is this woman freely able to enter into, and with whom?

[Question] Who therefore, comprise the seed of Sarah today?

[Question] How does their spirit anointing bring them to life?

3. Also since they are sinful and enslaved to sin, Yehowah God repurchases them through the blood of his son on earth, given in sacrifice in their behalf. Thus like faithful Ruth, they come to lie at the feet of the Greater Boaz, Jesus Christ on his earthly threshing floor and reap the benefits of the New Covenant through him, their repurchaser.

[Question] What then, does Yehowah God need to do to repurchase them from the sinful human family?

[Question] How then, are they like faithful Ruth?

4. Now this raises up a seed, not only for the Gentiles leading to Christ through the Greater Ruth the Moabitess, but also to the natural Israelites, the Greater Naomi, whose sons under the covenant had died, without raising up a seed to her, and who was past childbearing age. What tender affection Yehowah God expresses to faithful ones who love him, and look in faith to his promises!

[Question] Who then, does this raise up a seed for, through the marriage to Boaz of Ruth?

[Question] What does Yehowah God express to his people through this wonderful drama?

5' Meantime Boaz ate and drank, and his heart was feeling good. Then he went to lie down at the extremity of the grain heap. After that, she, Ruth, came stealthily and uncovered him at his feet and lay down. (Ruth 3:7)

[Question] Where did Ruth lay down, to invite Boaz to become her repurchaser?

6. And it came about at midnight, that the man began to tremble. So he bent himself forward, and, look! A woman lying at his feet! (Ruth 3:8)

[Question] What did Boaz awake in the middle of the night to find lying at his feet?

7. Then he said; Who are you? In turn she said; I am Ruth your slave girl, and you must spread out your skirt over your slave girl, for you are a repurchaser. (Ruth 3:9)

[Question] What then, did Ruth reveal about herself, and ask the man Boaz to do for her?

8. For your Grand Maker is your husbandly owner, Yehowah of armies being his name, and the Holy One of Israel is your Repurchaser. The God of the whole earth he will be called. (Isaiah 54:5)

[Question] What roles does Yehowah fulfill to his people?

9. Wherefore, brothers, we are children, not of a servant girl, but of the free woman. (Galatians 4:31)

[Question] Who then, are spirit anointed Christians sons of?

10" And I shall put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)

[Question] What would exist between the seed of the woman, Jesus Christ, and the seed of the serpent, Satan the Devil?

11. And all your sons will be persons taught by Yehowah, and

the peace of your sons will be abundant. (Isaiah 54:13)

[Question] Who teaches all anointed sons of God, through their spirit anointing?

12. As for us, our citizenship exists in the heavens, from which place also we are eagerly waiting for a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. (Philippians 3:20)

[Question] Where then, does the citizenship of anointed Christians belong?

13. And a great sign was seen in heaven, a woman arrayed with the sun, and the moon was beneath her feet, and on her head was a crown of twelve stars. (Revelation 12:1)

[Question] What woman was seen in a great sign in heaven, and who supports her in her role of bringing forth the Messianic child?

14. O that you were like a brother of mine, sucking the breasts of my mother! Should I find you outside, I would kiss you. People would not even despise me. (Song of Solomon 8:1)

[Question] How did the shepherd boy feel about his lover?

15. And you will certainly remember your ways and feel humiliated when you receive your sisters, the ones older than you as well as the ones younger than you, and I shall certainly give them to you as daughters, but not owing to your covenant. (Ezekiel 16:61)

[Question] What humiliation would those come to feel, who left the covenant of their God?
