Galatians 4:28~ Now we, brothers, are children belonging to the promise the same as Isaac was.

1. Paul now shows that we, both Gentile and Jewish Christians are children belonging to this promise made to Abraham, regarding him and Sarah, and the child to come forth through them, the Greater Isaac, Jesus Christ.

[Question] Who are now designated as sons of this free woman?
[Question] What must all sons within this covenant do, to seal it, before their God, in the flesh?

2. This child the Greater Abraham later symbolically offered up in sacrifice on Mount Moriah, there where the city of Jerusalem later came to stand. God will provide the sheep for the offering, my Son! Thus the Greater Abraham told his son he would be the sacrifice, just before he actually sacrificed him.

[Question] Where was this only-begotten sons to the Greater Abraham, later offered up in sacrifice?

[Question] What sacrifice did Yehowah God promise to provide, and what would his relationship be to the Greater Abraham?

3. To this Abraham said; God will provide himself the sheep for the burnt offering, my son. And both of them walked on together. (Genesis 22:8)

[Question] How did Abraham prophesy about the coming seed, who would serve as a sacrifice for all mankind, and who would provide it?

4. And they will make fun of him and will spit upon him and scourge him and kill him, but three days later he will rise. (Mark 10:34)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ prophesy about his death and resurrection?

5. For he was teaching his disciples and telling them; The Son of man is to be delivered into men's hands, and they will kill him, but, despite being killed, he will rise three days later. (Mark 9:31)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ say would happen to himself, before he ever died?

6. For just as Jonah was in the belly of the huge fish three days and three nights, so the Son of man will be in the heart of the earth three days and three nights. (Matthew 12:40)

[Question] What comparison did he make between himself and Jonah the prophet?

7. That is, the children in the flesh are not really the children of God, but the children by the promise are counted as the seed. (Romans 9:8)

[Question] Who then, are the children through the promise, who get counted as the true seed of Abraham?

8. Moreover, if you belong to Christ, you are really Abraham's seed, heirs with reference to a promise. (Galatians 3:29)

[Question] What are all those who belong to Christ?

9. To this God said; Sarah your wife is indeed bearing you a son, and you must call his name Isaac. And I will establish my covenant with him for a covenant to time indefinite to his seed after him. (Genesis 17:19)

[Question] What was the original promise made to Abraham and Sarah?

[Question] With what seed then, did Yehowah God initiate the New Covenant?

10. Reside as an alien in this land, and I shall continue with you and bless you, because to you and to your seed I shall give all these lands, and I will carry out the sworn statement that I swore to Abraham your father. (Genesis 26:3)

[Question] How was Abraham told to reside in the land of Canaan, until what happened?
