Galatians 4:4~ But when the full limit of the time arrived, God sent forth his Son, who came to be out of a woman and who came to be under Law.

1. But when the full limit of the time arrived, God sent forth his Son, who came to be born to a woman, and who was born to a people under the Law Covenant of Moses.

[Question] What then, did Yehowah God do, at the full limit of the appointed times?

2. And I shall put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head, and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)

[Question] What would exist between the woman and Satan the Devil throughout time?

[Question] What would also exist between their respective seeds?

3. The scepter will not turn aside from Judah, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to him, the obedience of the peoples will belong. (Genesis 49:10)

[Question] What would not turn aside from Judah until the coming Shiloh?

4. Look! Also, there was a voice from the heavens that said; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I have approved. (Matthew 3:17)

[Question] How did Yehowah God himself, reveal the identity of his Son?

5. Jesus said to them; If God were your Father, you would love me, for from God I came forth and am here. Neither have I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth. (John 8:42)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ say, that men would do regarding him, if they loved God his father?

6. So the Word became flesh and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved

kindness and truth. (John 1:14)

[Question] What did men get a small view of, when the Christ came to the earth?

[Question] What was Jesus Christ full of?

7. Indeed, the sacred secret of this godly devotion is admittedly great. He was made manifest in flesh, was declared righteous in spirit, appeared to angels, was preached about among nations, was believed upon in the world, was received up in glory. (1 Timothy 3:16)

[Question] How great was the sacred secret of this godly devotion?

8. Therefore, since the young children are sharers of blood and flesh, he also similarly partook of the same things, that through his death he might bring to nothing, the one having the means to cause death, that is, the Devil. (Hebrews 2:14)

[Question] What did the Christ partake of, and why so?

9. Do not think I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I came, not to destroy, but to fulfill. (Matthew 5:17)

[Question] What should we not think, that Christ came to accomplish, for what was his real purpose?

10" Therefore say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; There will be no postponement anymore as to any words of mine. What word I shall speak, it will even be done, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 12:28)

[Question] What does Yehowah God promise to do respecting his word, when the time comes for the fulfillment of all things?

11. And saying; The appointed time has been fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has drawn near. Be repentant, you people, and have faith in the Good News. (Mark 1:15)

[Question] What message did Christ carry forth to the people?

12. One more he had, a beloved son. He sent him forth last to them, saying; They will respect my son. (Mark 12:6)

[Question] Whom did Yehowah God send forth last to the people, to get what was owing to him?

13. And, look! You will conceive in your womb and give birth to a son, and you are to call his name Jesus. (Luke 1:31)

[Question] What was faithful Mary told by the angel of Yehowah God?

14. With loyalty and righteousness before him all our days. (Luke 1:75)

[Question] How did Zechariah want to serve his God?

15. Now when eight days came to the full for circumcising him, his name was also called Jesus, the name called by the angel before he was conceived in the womb. (Luke 2:21)

[Question] When was Jesus Christ named, and was he circumcised?

16. Concerning his Son, who sprang from the seed of David according to the flesh. (Romans 1:3)

[Question] Whose seed did Jesus Christ spring from according to the flesh?

17. For, there being an incapability on the part of the Law, while it was weak through the flesh, God, by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and concerning sin, condemned sin in the flesh. (Romans 8:3)

[Question] What was the Law Covenant weak toward?

[Question] What did Jesus Christ condemn in the flesh through his life course?

18. However, before the faith arrived, we were being guarded under Law, being delivered up together into custody, looking to the faith, that was destined to be revealed. (Galatians 3:23)

[Question] How were Jewish Christians being guarded, before the coming of the Messiah, and what were they looking to in faith?

19. Has at the end of these days spoken to us by means of a Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the systems of things. (Hebrews 1:2)

[Question] Who has God at last spoken to mankind through, and what has he granted to this one to become?

20" Otherwise, he would have to suffer often from the founding of the world. But now he has manifested himself once for all time at the conclusion of the systems of things to put sin away through the sacrifice of himself. (Hebrews 9:26)

[Question] How many times would the Christ have to suffer death?

21. Yes, the life was made manifest, and we have seen and are bearing witness and reporting to you the everlasting life which was with the Father and was made manifest to us. (1 John 1:2)
