

**Galatians 5:14~** For the entire Law stands fulfilled in one saying, namely:  
**You must<sup>1</sup> love your neighbor as yourself.**

**1·** Now the entire Law Covenant stands fulfilled in one statement as respects other people: You must love your neighbor as yourself. Jesus Christ had already taught this, and it is the second most important commandment, the first being to; Love Yehowah God with our whole heart, spirit, mind and strength. How fitting circumcision is then, to maintaining clean relationships with others, and in doing all things in love.

**[Question]** What does circumcision, then help us to maintain throughout life with others?

**2·** Do not you people be owing anybody a single thing, except to **love** one another, for he that **loves** his fellowman has **fulfilled** the Law. (**Romans 13:8**)

**[Question]** What alone should we be owing, to one another?

**3·** You **must** not take vengeance nor have a grudge against the sons of your people, and you **must love** your fellow as yourself. I am Yehowah. (**Leviticus 19:18**)

**[Question]** What must we not take against a brother, or hold against him over anything?

**[Question]** What positive command does the Law Covenant make?

**4·** All things, therefore, that you want men to do to you, you also **must** likewise do to them. This, in fact, is what the **Law** and the Prophets mean. (**Matthew 7:12**)

**[Question]** How should we treat others?

**[Question]** How might we sum up the many statements of the Law Covenant?

**5·** The second, like it, is this: You **must love** your **neighbor** as yourself. (**Matthew 22:39**)

**[Question]** What is the second most important command of the Law Covenant?

- 6· If, now, you practice carrying out the kingly Law according to the scripture: You **must love** your **neighbor** as **yourself**. You are doing quite well. (**James 2:8**)

**[Question]** What is the kingly Law?

- 7· On these two commandments the whole **Law** hangs, and the Prophets. (**Matthew 22:40**)

**[Question]** What hangs, on just two fine statements?

- 8· The second is this: You **must love** your **neighbor** as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these. (**Mark 12:31**)

**[Question]** What is the second most important commandment?

- 9· In answer he said: You **must love** Yehowah your God with your whole heart and with your whole soul and with your whole strength and with your whole mind, and, your **neighbor** as yourself. (**Luke 10:27**)

**[Question]** What is a fine summation of the entire Law Covenant?
