Galatians 5:16~ But I say; Keep walking by spirit and you will carry out no fleshly desire at all.

1. Paul now encourages all anointed Christians to keep on walking by means of their love of the Holy Spirit, with which they have been anointed by God. If they do so, then they will carry out no fleshly desires at all, and they will then firm up their hope of everlasting live in God's presence, after their death in the flesh.

[Question] What course does Paul now encourage them to keep on walking in?

[Question] What will all those who follow the spirit, not carry out at all?

2. For those who are in accord with the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those in accord with the spirit, on the things of the spirit. (Romans 8:5)

[Question] What do those who walk in accord with the flesh set their minds on?

[Question] What do those walking in accord with the spirit set their minds on?

3. For if you live in accord with the flesh, you are sure to die, but if you put the practices of the body to death by the spirit, you will live. (Romans 8:13)

[Question] What will surely happen to all those walking in accord with the flesh?

[Question] What course must we follow to get life?

4. Therefore, do not let sin continue to rule as king in your mortal bodies, that you should obey their desires. (Romans 6:12)

[Question] What should not rule over us any longer, if we are truly following the spirit of God?

5 Beloved, I exhort you as aliens and temporary residents, to keep abstaining from fleshly desires, which are the very ones, that carry on a conflict against the soul. (1 Peter 2:11)

[Question] What did Peter encourage anointed Christians to keep abstaining from, and why?

6. For the Law of that spirit which gives life in union with Christ Jesus, has set you free from the Law of sin and of death. (Romans 8:2)

[Question] The Law of what spirit, set us free from the Law Covenant, the Law of sin and death?

7' That the righteous requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who walk, not in accord with the flesh, but in accord with the spirit. (Romans 8:4)

[Question] Who will fulfill the righteous requirements of the Law Covenant, by actually living up to its principles?

8. But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not be planning ahead for the desires of the flesh. (Romans 13:14)

[Question] If we put on the Lord Jesus Christ, what will we not be planning ahead for?

9. To the end that you should go on walking worthily of God who is calling you to his kingdom and glory. (1 Thessalonians 2:12)

[Question] What end result are all anointed Christians working toward?

10. Accordingly, put away all badness and all deceitfulness and hypocrisy and envies and all sorts of backbiting. (1 Peter 2:1)

[Question] What kinds of bad behaviors, should we put completely away from us?
