Galatians 5:18~ Furthermore, if you are being led by spirit, you are not under Law.

1. Paul now shows, that all Christians who are anointed ones are being led by the spirit of God, for they are in the New Covenant, and have received an anointing from God. They have died to the Law Covenant, through undeserved kindness, and they walk in a new way, to the same course of obeying the Law Covenant's fine tenets and principles, but through love of the spirit, and not by means of a written code, that condemns to death.

[Question] What are all anointed ones, who follow the Holy Spirit, no longer under, and why?

[Question] What is the new course, that they are following obediently through the New Covenant?

[Question] Have they changed course, or changed the motivation within them?

2. For all who are led by God's spirit, these are God's sons. (Romans 8:14)

[Question] Who are God's sons?

3. For sin must not be master over you, seeing that you are not under Law, but under undeserved kindness. (Romans 6:14)

[Question] What must not be a master over us, since we are under undeserved kindness, and not under Law?

4. For the Law of that spirit, which gives life in union with Christ Jesus, has set you free, from the Law of sin and of death. (Romans 8:2)

[Question] What has the Law of the spirit set anointed Christians free from, and how so?

5. Thanks to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So, then, with my mind I myself am a slave to God's Law, but with my flesh to sin's Law. (Romans 7:25)

[Question] What are anointed ones, slaves to, within their minds?

[Question] What though, is the flesh always a slave to?

[Question] Which one, must win out in this struggle?

6. That the righteous requirement of the Law might be fulfilled in us who walk, not in accord with the flesh, but in accord with the spirit. (Romans 8:4)

[Question] Who will actually come to fulfill the Law Covenant, through their love of the spirit of God?

7. Now Yehowah is the Spirit. Where the spirit of Yehowah is, there is freedom. (2 Corinthians 3:17)

[Question] What accompanies the Holy Spirit?
