Galatians 5:21~ Envies, drunken bouts, revelries, and things like these. As to these things I am forewarning you, the same way as I did forewarn you, that those who practice such things will not inherit God's kingdom.

1 Then Paul lists some more of these wicked practices like envy, drunken bouts, revelries and other forms of lawless behavior. Then he makes his point, with a very strong warning.

**[Question]** What are still more, of these works of the flesh?

2. Anyone practicing these things will not inherit the Kingdom of God! Any Christian today, who thinks, that, because we are not under the Law Covenant today, that he or she can do the things, that the Law Covenant condemned, is sorely misled!

[Question] What will anyone practice such things not inherit?

[Question] What then, will happen to any Christian today, who thinks that, just because we are not under the Law Covenant, that he or she can do such things with impunity?

3. Christians are to fulfill the Law Covenant through their love of the spirit of God, and they will even more closely live by all its guiding principles, than the Jews did, because they have the means to make it succeed, their spirit anointing, and their love of the spirit of God, who touches our hearts and writes his Laws there upon our hearts, in love.

[Question] How then, must anointed Christians live, and what is it their goal to actually fulfill?

[Question] What force guiding them, will lead them to success in this goal, if they follow it closely?

4. Also Christians will not become nit-picking, like the Jews did, because it is not about works of righteousness, but about faith in Christ, and a about continuing effort from the heart to live according to divine principles, through love of the Holy Spirit.

[Question] What should anointed Christians also never become, and why?

[Question] How should we feel about, and encourage the fine works, of one another?

5. And they must say to the older men of his city; This son of

ours is stubborn and rebellious, he is not listening to our voice, being a glutton and a drunkard. (Deuteronomy 21:20)

[Question] What were faithful parents to do, with a rebellious and stubborn son?

6. Woe to those who are getting up early in the morning that they may seek just intoxicating liquor, who are lingering till late in the evening darkness so that wine itself inflames them! (Isaiah 5:11)

[Question] What would come upon those, who drink too much?

7. For the time that has passed by is sufficient for you to have worked out the will of the nations when you proceeded in deeds of loose conduct, lusts, excesses with wine, revelries, drinking matches, and illegal idolatries. (1 Peter 4:3)

[Question] What should have been enough for anointed Christians before their baptism?

8. For if you live in accord with the flesh you are sure to die, but if you put the practices of the body to death by the spirit, you will live. (Romans 8:13)

[Question] What is the sure end of those living according to the flesh?
[Question] What course alone leads to life?

9. Perhaps, when I come again, my God might humiliate me among you, and I might mourn over many of those who formerly sinned, but have not repented over their uncleanness and fornication and loose conduct, that they have practiced. (2 Corinthians 12:21)

[Question] What would Paul have to mourn over, if they failed to repent of their wicked works?

10" What! Do you not know that unrighteous persons will not inherit God's kingdom? Do not be misled! Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men kept for unnatural purposes, nor men who lie with men. (1 Corinthians 6:9)

[Question] Who will not inherit God's Kingdom?

[Question] What are a few of the wicked works, that will keep one out of the Kingdom of God?

11. Wine is a ridiculer, intoxicating liquor is boisterous, and everyone going astray by it is not wise. (Proverbs 20:1)

[Question] What is everyone going astray by wine and liquor to the excess?

12. For a drunkard and a glutton will come to poverty, and drowsiness will clothe one with mere rags. (Proverbs 23:21)

[Question] What will both a drunkard, a glutton and a lazy person all come to?

13. But now I am writing you to quit mixing in company with anyone called a brother that is a fornicator or a greedy person or an idolater or a reviler or a drunkard or an extortioner, not even eating with such a man. (1 Corinthians 5:11)

[Question] Whom should anointed Christians avoid association with, who is called a brother, and is doing what things?

[Question] Under these guidelines, should true Christians have anything to do with child molesting priests?

14. For you know this, recognizing it for yourselves, that no fornicator or unclean person or greedy person, which means being an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of the Christ and of God. (Ephesians 5:5)

[Question] What kinds of persons, have no inheritance in the Kingdom of God?

15. He is puffed up with pride, not understanding anything, but being mentally diseased over questionings and debates about words. From these things spring envy, strife, abusive speeches, wicked suspicions. (1 Timothy 6:4)

[Question] What do many who are mentally diseased, get involved in fighting over?

[Question] What kinds of wicked acts spring forth from such ones?

16. Let marriage be honorable among all, and the marriage bed be without defilement, for God will judge fornicators and

adulterers. (Hebrews 13:4)

[Question] How should the marriage bed become within the congregation?

17. Accordingly, put away all badness and all deceitfulness and hypocrisy and envies and all sorts of backbiting. (1 Peter 2:1)

[Question] What sorts of bad qualities, should anointed Christians put away completely?

18. But anything not sacred, and anyone that carries on a disgusting thing and a lie, will in no way enter into it, only those written in the Lamb's scroll of life will. (Revelation 21:27)

[Question] What will in no way enter into the Kingdom of God?
