Galatians 5:3~ Moreover, I bear witness again to every man getting circumcised, that he is under obligation to perform the whole Law.

1. Here again, Paul by using the argument, that the circumcision was a pattern of the Law Covenant, tries to bring us under obligation to perform the whole Law Covenant, if we get circumcised. This is simply not the case.

[Question] What does Paul here try to argue, because he wrongly thought that the circumcision was part of the Law Covenant?

[Question] Is this the case, and should we get circumcised today?

2. Circumcision is part of a different covenant, that of (Genesis 17:1-14), a covenant, that prefigured the New Covenant with the seed of the Greater Abraham, the Greater Isaac, Jesus and his spiritual seed after him.

[Question] Where did the original command to circumcise come forth from?

[Question] Also what seed of promise did this covenant point forward to?

3. They are to be circumcised at birth by fathers who love God and want their sons to stay in the covenant of freedom, and during their lives they circumcise their hearts spiritually by their love of the spirit of Yehowah God.

[Question] Who circumcises a man, and when in his life cycle?

[Question] Who then, makes the commitment to raise up one as circumcised?

[Question] What then, does the circumcision of the flesh remind a son of, throughout his life, that he needs to do with his heart?

4 Circumcision is, in fact, of benefit only if you practice Law, but if you are a transgressor of Law, your circumcision has become uncircumcision. (Romans 2:25)

[Question] What does a man's circumcision become, if he breaks the Law Covenant?

5. For all those who depend upon works of Law are under a curse, for it is written: Cursed is every one, that does not continue in all the things written in the scroll of the Law, in order to do them. (Galatians 3:10)
