

Galatians 6:10~ Really, then, as long as we have time favorable for it, let us work what is good toward all, but especially toward those related to us in the faith.

- 1• So then as long as time remains for it, let us work these fine Christian works toward one another, and to all men. However, our Christian brothers should receive our special attention, for they are responsive to good counsel and instruction, and like us, they are always trying to gain a better knowledge of God, and more spiritual wisdom in applying Christian principles, and like us, they love the truth.

[Question] Whom should we especially focus our good works upon, and why them?

- 2• We must **work** the **works** of him that sent me while it is day, the night is coming when no man can **work**. (**John 9:4**)

[Question] What works must we try to work during the day?

- 3• Go on walking in wisdom **toward** those on the outside, buying out the opportune time for yourselves. (**Colossians 4:5**)

[Question] How should we walk toward those outside of the Christian congregation?

- 4• Certainly, therefore, you are no longer strangers and alien residents, but you are fellow citizens of the holy ones and are members of the household of God. (**Ephesians 2:19**)

[Question] What have all anointed ones become through their anointing?

- 5• You must not see the ass of your brother or his bull fall down on the road, and deliberately withdraw from them. You should by all means help him raise them up. (**Deuteronomy 22:4**)

[Question] What should one do even for an enemy, but especially for a brother?

- 6• Or, rather, that there may be an interchange of encouragement among you, by each one through the other's **faith**, both yours and mine. (**Romans 1:12**)

[Question] How does the doing of good works toward our brothers provide for an interchange of encouragement for all?
