

Galatians 6:15~ For neither is circumcision anything nor is uncircumcision, but a new creation is something.

- 1· Paul now states, that neither is circumcision or uncircumcision important relatively, in relation to the importance of becoming a new creation. That is the goal, towards which all Christians are reaching out, through faith and love of the spirit. Reaching that goal, is what is the most important thing.

[Question] What does Paul now place superior importance upon?

- 2· For as regards Christ Jesus neither circumcision is of any value nor is **uncircumcision**, but faith operating through love is. (**Galatians 5:6**)

[Question] What did Paul also put superior importance upon?

- 3· Consequently if anyone is in union with Christ, he is a **new creation**, the old things passed away, look! **New** things have come into existence. (**2 Corinthians 5:17**)

[Question] What is anyone in union with Christ?

- 4· For we are a product of his work, and were created in union with Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in them. (**Ephesians 2:10**)

[Question] Why were we created by God in union with Jesus Christ?

- 5· In answer Jesus said to him; Most truly I say to you, unless anyone is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. (**John 3:3**)

[Question] What must happen to any human, before he may see the Kingdom of God?

- 6· Therefore we were buried with him through our baptism into his death, in order, that, just as Christ was raised up from the dead through the glory of the Father, we also, should likewise walk in a newness of life. (**Romans 6:4**)

[Question] What course were we buried into through baptism?

[Question] What newness of life should we walk in, even now?

[Question] What therefore do we expect, like Christ received, after our deaths in the flesh?

- 7· Clear away the old leaven, that you may be a **new** lump, according as you are free from ferment. For, indeed, Christ our Passover has been sacrificed. (**1 Corinthians 5:7**)

[Question] What should we clear away from our lives represented by the leaven, and why?

- 8· Circumcision does not mean a thing, and **uncircumcision** means not a thing, but observance of God's commandments does. (**1 Corinthians 7:19**)

[Question] What is most important for us to do?
