Footnote: Or, Finally

1· Hence, Paul asked, that no one among them might make any trouble for him, for he was carrying on his body the brand marks, from 5 lashings of 39 strokes and three beating with rods and one stoning, those marks of a slave of Jesus Christ. He had endured by putting his faith to the test, and had succeeded in putting his fleshly desires to death by his love of God's spirit of holiness.

[Question] What then, had Paul succeeded in doing through his love of the spirit?

2· Always we endure everywhere in our body the death-dealing treatment given to Jesus, that the life of Jesus may also be made manifest in our body. (2 Corinthians 4:10)

[Question] What do anointed Christians always everywhere endure, and why so?

3· So as to know him and the power of his resurrection, and a sharing in his sufferings, submitting myself to a death like his. (Philippians 3:10)

[Question] What did Paul, and many other anointed Christians submit themselves to, and why?
