1· In respect to what each of us actually does in life, each one will carry his own load of responsibility before God for what he himself does. We are counseled to help one another to carry our burdens, but then what we ourselves do, is the basis for how we will be judged. Helping others with their issues, will go a long way towards forgiveness, for this is Godlike.

[Question] What are we encouraged to do for others, but what will be the basis of our judgment?

[Question] What also will go a long way toward making us more godlike?

2· Who are you to judge the house servant of another? To his own master he stands or falls. Indeed, he will be made to stand, for Yehowah can make him stand. (Romans 14:4)

[Question] Should we ever even try to judge another, give reasons?

3· For we must all be made manifest before the judgment seat of the Christ, that each one may get his award for the things done through the body, according to the things he has practiced, whether it is good or vile. (2 Corinthians 5:10)

[Question] Where will all anointed Christians come before for judgment, and how will this judgment proceed?
