Galatians 6:6~ Moreover, let anyone who is being orally taught¹ the word share in all good things with the one who gives such oral teaching.

Footnote: Literally, being sounded down to Greek, ka·te·khou'me·nos; Latin, ca·te·ci·za'tur

1. Moreover Paul counsels, that anyone who is being orally taught the word, should share his material things with the one giving such oral teaching. Why? Because the one doing so is providing him with a service, working for him. Also they both should share in the same spiritual things, in all their depth and breadth.

[Question] What should the one receiving spiritual instruction share with the one giving such instruction, and why so?

2. That you may know fully, the certainty of the things, that you have been taught orally. (Luke 1:4)

[Question] What did Luke share with Theophilus?

3. This man had been orally instructed in the way of Yehowah and, as he was aglow with the spirit, he went speaking and teaching with correctness the things about Jesus, but being acquainted with only the baptism of John. (Acts of Apostles 18:25)

[Question] What was the condition of Apollos when he first entered the congregation, but what did he need to learn, and who took him under their wing and taught him?

4. Then Moses said to Aaron and his sons; Boil the flesh at the entrance of the tent of meeting, and there is where you will eat it and the bread that is in the installation basket, just as I was given the command, saying; Aaron and his sons will eat it. (Leviticus 8:31)

[Question] What provisions did the Law Covenant make for the priests to eat from the sacrificial offerings?

5. So stay in that house, eating and drinking the things they provide, for the worker is worthy of his wages. Do not be transferring from house to house. (Luke 10:7)

[Question] What did Jesus Christ counsel his disciples to do when preaching, and where should they stay?

6. True, they have been pleased to do so, and yet they were debtors to them, for if the nations have shared in their spiritual things, they also owe it to minister publicly to these with things for the fleshly body. (Romans 15:27)

[Question] What did the anointed ones from among the nations owe to the Jewish anointed Christians, for their service toward them?

7' If we have sown spiritual things to you, is it something great, if we shall reap things for the flesh from you? (1 Corinthians 9:11)

[Question] What things did Paul show, that it was proper for him to receive back from them, for his spiritual work among them?

8' Moreover, do not forget the doing of good and the sharing of things with others, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. (Hebrews 13:16)

[Question] What things should an anointed Christians not forget to do, and why?

9. And you must eat it in every place, you and your household, because it is your wages in return for your service in the tent of meeting. (Numbers 18:31)

[Question] What were the priests given, for their service in the tent of meeting?

10" Or a food pouch for the trip, or two undergarments, or sandals or a staff, for the worker deserves his food.

(Matthew 10:10)

[Question] What were early Christians disciples not to take with them when preaching, and why?

11. In this way, too, the Lord ordained for those proclaiming the Good News to live by means of the Good News. (1 Corinthians 9:14)

[Question] How did the Lord ordain for those preaching the Good News of God to maintain their lives?

12. And to the sons of Levi, look! I have given every tenth part in Israel as an inheritance in return for their service, that they are carrying on, the service of the tent of meeting. (Numbers 18:21)

[Question] What were the sons of Levi given for their service at the tent of meeting?

13. Then Moses gave the tax as Yehowah's contribution to Eleazar the priest, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. (Numbers 31:41)

[Question] What tax was made yearly to support the priesthood within Israel?

14. At this Saul said to his attendant; And if we should go, what shall we bring to the man? Because the bread itself has disappeared from our receptacles, and, as a gift, there is nothing to bring to the man of the true God. What is there with us? (1 Samuel 9:7)

[Question] What did Saul worry about bringing to the man of the true God as a gift for his services?

15. And there was a man that came from Baal-shalishah, and he came bringing to the man of the true God bread of the first ripe fruits, twenty barley loaves, and new grain in his bread bag. Then he said; Give it to the people that they may eat. (2 Kings 4:42)

[Question] What did the man from Baal-shalishah bring to the man of the true God?

16. Do not hold back good from those to whom it is owing, when it happens to be in the power of your hand, to do it. (Proverbs 3:27)

[Question] What should we never hold back from those to whom it is owing, if we are able to give it?

17. Also, he gave them orders to carry nothing for the trip except a staff alone, no bread, no food pouch, no copper money in their girdle purses. (Mark 6:8)

[Question] What orders did Jesus Christ give his disciples when preaching?

18. And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira and a worshiper of God, was listening, and Yehowah opened her heart wide to pay attention to the things being spoken by Paul. (Acts of Apostles 16:14)

[Question] How did Lydia react to the Good News, and what did she open up for them to stay?

19. Now when she and her household got baptized, she said with entreaty; If you men have judged me to be faithful to Yehowah, enter into my house and stay. And she just made us come. (Acts of Apostles 16:15)

[Question] What did she say after getting baptized?

20" Or a ministry, let us be at this ministry, or he that teaches, let him be at his teaching. (Romans 12:7)

[Question] What should we be working at diligently?

21. Because the ministry of this public service is not only to supply abundantly the wants of the holy ones, but also to be rich with many expressions of thanks to God. (2 Corinthians 9:12)

[Question] What was the purpose, behind Paul's organizing of a relief ministration?

22. For the scripture says: You must not muzzle a bull when it threshes out the grain. And also: The workman is worthy of his wages. (1 Timothy 5:18)

[Question] What must not be muzzled, when threshing the grain, and how does this apply to men?

23. Carefully supply Zenas, who is versed in the Law, and Apollos for their trip, that they may not lack anything. (Titus 3:13)

[Question] What did Paul ask of Titus?
