

Galatians 6:8~

Because he who is sowing with a view to his flesh will reap corruption from his flesh, but he who is sowing with a view to the spirit will reap everlasting life from the spirit.

- 1· Anyone sowing with a view to his flesh, will reap corruption from the flesh. However, he who is sowing with a view to the spirit, will reap everlasting life from the spirit.**

[Question] What will anyone sowing with regard to the flesh reap?

[Question] What will the one sowing with regard to the spirit, reap from the spirit?

- 2· Our course then, as Christians, is clearly set out here. It is a theme of all Paul's writings. We must learn to put to death, the desires of the flesh, through our love of the Holy Spirit sent to us, by God, through our anointing as his prospective sons. We must not live in imitation of other worldly men.**

[Question] What course then, is clearly set out as a general theme of all Paul's writings?

[Question] Who then, must we not imitate to please God?

- 3· For the minding of the **flesh** means death, but the minding of the **spirit** means **life** and peace. (**Romans 8:6**)**

[Question] What does the minding of the desires of the flesh, mean for us in the future?

[Question] What does the minding of the spirit, mean for our future?

- 4· It is the **spirit** that is life-giving. The **flesh** is of no use at all. The sayings that I have spoken to you, are **spirit**, and are **life**. (**John 6:63**)**

[Question] What part of our being is life-giving?

[Question] What are the sayings of Christ?

- 5· For if you live in accord with the **flesh** you are sure to die. If you put the practices of the body to death by the **spirit**, you **will** live. (**Romans 8:13**)**

[Question] What will surely happen to anyone living according to the desires of the flesh?

[Question] What will happen to anyone putting to death the desires of the flesh, through his love of the Holy Spirit?

- 6· Say, you men, that it **will** be well with the righteous ones, for they **will** eat the very fruitage of their dealings. (**Isaiah 3:10**)

[Question] What will also the righteous ones eat from?

- 7· Yet these men are speaking abusively of all the things they really do not know. But all the things that they do understand naturally like the unreasoning animals, in these things they go on corrupting themselves. (**Jude 1:10**)

[Question] What do non-spiritual men revel in?

- 8· The activity of the righteous one results in **life**. The produce of the wicked one results in sin. (**Proverbs 10:16**)

[Question] What is the result of the activity of the righteous ones, and of the wicked ones?

- 9· The wicked one is making false wages, but the one **sowing** righteousness, true earnings. (**Proverbs 11:18**)

[Question] What are the rewards to wicked ones likened to, and the rewards of the righteous likened to?

- 10· The one faithless at heart **will** be satisfied with the results of his own ways, but the good man with the results of his dealings. (**Proverbs 14:14**)

[Question] What does the one faithless at heart find satisfying?
