Ephesians 1:13" But you also hoped in him after you heard the word of truth, the Good News about your salvation. By means of him also, after you believed, 1 you were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit.

- Because of the hope that is being reserved for you in the heavens. This hope you heard of before by the telling of the truth of that Good News (Colossians 1:5)
- Whose will is that all sorts of men should be saved and come to an accurate knowledge of truth. (1 Timothy 2:4)
- He has also put his seal upon us and has given us the token of what is to come, that is, the spirit, in our hearts. (2 Corinthians 1:22)
- Also, do not be grieving God's Holy Spirit, with which you have been sealed for a day of releasing by ransom. (Ephesians 4:30)
- And I heard the number of those who were sealed, a hundred and forty-four thousand, sealed out of every tribe of the sons of Israel. (Revelation 7:4)
- This alone I want to learn from you; Did you receive the spirit due to works of Law or due to a hearing by faith? (Galatians 3:2)
- Do not let YOUR hearts be troubled. Exercise faith in God, exercise faith also in me. (John 14:1)
- But who with power was declared God's Son according to the spirit of holiness by means of resurrection from the dead, yes, Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 1:4)
- And the hope does not lead to disappointment, because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, which was given us. (Romans 5:5)
- For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope, for when a man sees a thing, does he hope for it? (Romans 8:24)
- Now whether we are in tribulation, it is for YOUR comfort and salvation, or whether we are being comforted, it is for YOUR

- comfort that operates to make you endure the same sufferings that we also suffer. (2 Corinthians 1:6)
- Saying; Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until after we have sealed the slaves of our God in their foreheads. (Revelation 7:3)
