- For Yehowah himself **gives wisdom**, out of his mouth there are **knowledge** and discernment. (**Proverbs 2:6**)
- That is also why we, from the day we heard of it, have not ceased praying for **YOU** and asking that **YOU** may be filled with the **accurate knowledge** of his will in all **wisdom** and spiritual comprehension. (**Colossians 1:9**)
- Whose will is that all sorts of men should be saved and come to an **accurate knowledge** of truth. (**1 Timothy 2:4**)
- And you yourself are to speak to all the ones wise with a heart that I have filled with the **spirit of wisdom**, and they must make Aaron's garments for sanctifying him, that he may act as priest to me. (**Exodus 28:3**)
- And upon him the **spirit** of Yehowah must settle down, the **spirit of wisdom** and of understanding, the **spirit** of counsel and of mightiness, the **spirit of knowledge** and of the fear of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 11:2**)
- And he is changing times and seasons, removing kings and setting up kings, giving **wisdom** to the wise ones and **knowledge** to those knowing discernment. (**Daniel 2:21**)
- **Jesus** said to her; Stop clinging to me. For I have not yet ascended to the **Father**. But be on your way to my brothers and say to them, I am ascending to my **Father** and **YOUR Father** and to my God and **YOUR** God. (**John 20:17**)
- For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to **accurate knowledge**. (**Romans 10:2**)
- That **YOUR** faith might be, not in men's **wisdom**, but in God's power. (**1 Corinthians 2:5**)

- **For example, to one there is given through the **spirit** speech of **wisdom**, to another speech of **knowledge** according to the same **spirit**. (1 Corinthians 12:8)**
- **In order to walk worthily of Yehowah to the end of fully pleasing him as **you** go on bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the **accurate knowledge** of God. (Colossians 1:10)**
