Ephesians 1:22... He also subjected all things under his feet, and made him head over all things to the congregation.

[8] - References:

- You make him dominate over the works of your hands, everything you have put under his feet. (Psalms 8:6)
- And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (Matthew 28:18)
- Because a husband is head of his wife as the Christ also is head of the congregation, he being a savior of this body. (Ephesians 5:23)
- And he is the head of the body, the congregation. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that he might become the one who is first in all things. (Colossians 1:18)
- And to him there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership that will not pass away, and his kingdom one that will not be brought to ruin. (Daniel 7:14)
- For God, subjected all things under his feet. But when he says that 'all things have been subjected, it is evident that it is with the exception of the one who subjected all things to him. (1 Corinthians 15:27)
- Whereas he is not holding fast to the head, to the one from whom all the body, being supplied and harmoniously joined together by means of its joints and ligaments, goes on growing with the growth that God gives. (Colossians 2:19)
- All things you subjected under his feet. For in that he subjected all things to him God left nothing that is not subject to him. Now, though, we do not yet see all things in subjection to him. (Hebrews 2:8)
