

Ephesians 1:22 He also subjected all things under his feet, and made him head over all things to the congregation.

[8] - References:

- You make him dominate over the works of your hands, everything you have put **under** his **feet**. (**Psalms 8:6**)
- And Jesus approached and spoke to them, saying; All authority has been given me in heaven and on the earth. (**Matthew 28:18**)
- Because a husband is **head** of his wife as the Christ also is **head** of the **congregation**, he being a savior of this body. (**Ephesians 5:23**)
- And he is the **head** of the body, the **congregation**. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that he might become the one who is first in all **things**. (**Colossians 1:18**)
- And to him there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership that will not pass away, and his kingdom one that will not be brought to ruin. (**Daniel 7:14**)
- For God, subjected all **things under** his feet. But when he says that `all **things** have been subjected, it is evident that it is with the exception of the one who subjected all **things** to him. (**1 Corinthians 15:27**)
- Whereas he is not holding fast to the **head**, to the one from whom all the body, being supplied and harmoniously joined together by means of its joints and ligaments, goes on growing with the growth that God gives. (**Colossians 2:19**)
- All **things** you subjected **under** his feet. For in that he subjected all **things** to him God left nothing that is not subject to him. Now, though, we do not yet see all **things** in subjection to him. (**Hebrews 2:8**)
