- You are the ones blessed by Yehowah, the Maker of heaven and earth. (Psalms 115:15)
- May You have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Corinthians 1:2)
- That he was caught away into paradise and heard unutterable words which it is not lawful for a man to speak. (2 Corinthians 12:4)
- That in the coming systems of things there might be demonstrated the surpassing riches of his undeserved kindness in his graciousness toward us in union with Christ Jesus. (Ephesians 2:7)
