of the world, that we should be holy and without blemish before him in love.

- You are my witnesses, is the utterance of Yehowah, even my servant whom I have chosen, in order that you may know and have faith in me, and that you may understand that I am the same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none. (Isaiah 43:10)
- Father, as to what you have given me, I wish that, where I am, they also may be with me, in order to behold my glory that you have given me, because you loved me before the founding of the world. (John 17:24)
- Jude, a slave of Jesus Christ, but a brother of James, to the called ones who are loved in relationship with God the Father and preserved for Jesus Christ. (Jude 1:1)
- True, he was foreknown before the founding of the world, but he was made manifest at the end of the times for the sake of YOU (1 Peter 1:20)
- That he might present the congregation to himself in its splendor, not having a spot or a wrinkle or any of such things, but that it should be holy and without blemish. (Ephesians 5:27)
- He now has again reconciled by means of that one's fleshly body through his death, in order to present YOU holy and unblemished and open to no accusation before him. (Colossians 1:22)
- Listen, my beloved brothers. God chose the ones who are poor respecting the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom, which he promised to those who love him, did he not? (James 2:5)
- Speak to the entire assembly of the sons of Israel, and you must say to them, you should prove yourselves holy, because I Yehowah your God am holy. (Leviticus 19:2)

- And you must sanctify yourselves and prove yourselves holy, because I am Yehowah your God. (Leviticus 20:7)
- You are altogether beautiful, O girl companion of mine, and there is no defect in you. (Song of Solomon 4:7)
- In fact, unless Yehowah had cut short the days, no flesh would be saved. But on account of the chosen ones whom he has chosen he has cut short the days. (Mark 13:20)
- I am not talking about all of YOU, I know the ones I have chosen. But it is in order that the Scripture might be fulfilled, He that used to feed on my bread has lifted up his heel against me. (John 13:18)
- For we are a product of his work and were created in union with Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10)
- However, we are obligated to thank God always for You, brothers loved by Yehowah, because God selected You from the beginning for salvation by sanctifying You with spirit and by Your faith in the truth. (2 Thessalonians 2:13)
- He saved us and called us with a holy calling, not by reason of our works, but by reason of his own purpose and undeserved kindness. This was given us in connection with Christ Jesus before times long lasting. (2 Timothy 1:9)
- For we who have exercised faith do enter into the rest, just as he has said; So I swore in my anger, They shall not enter into my rest, although his works were finished from the founding of the world. (Hebrews 4:3)
- Otherwise, he would have to suffer often from the founding of the world. But now he has manifested himself once for all time at the conclusion of the systems of things to put sin away through the sacrifice of himself. (Hebrews 9:26)
- Now to the one who is able to guard you from stumbling and to set you unblemished in the sight of his glory with great joy. (Jude 1:24)
- And all those who dwell on the earth will worship it, the name of not one of them stands written in the scroll of life of the Lamb

who was slaughtered, from the founding of the world. (Revelation 13:8)
