Ephesians 2:15. By means of his flesh he abolished the enmity, the Law of commandments consisting in decrees, that he might create the two peoples in union with himself into one new man and make peace.

- For, there being an incapability on the part of the Law, while it was weak through the flesh, God, by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and concerning sin, condemned sin in the flesh. (Romans 8:3)
- In reply, however, she said to him; Yes, sir, and yet the little dogs underneath the table eat of the crumbs of the little children. (Mark 7:28)
- And what great nation is there that has righteous regulations and judicial decisions like all this Law that I am putting before YOU today? (Deuteronomy 4:8)
- But glory and honor and peace for everyone who works what is good, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. (Romans 2:10)
- For just as the body is one but has many members, and all the members of that body, although being many, are one body, so also is the Christ. (1 Corinthians 12:12)
- And YOU must keep this thing as a regulation for you and your sons to time indefinite. (Exodus 12:24)
- But now we have been discharged from the Law, because we have died to that by which we were being held fast, that we might be slaves in a new sense by the spirit, and not in the old sense by the written code. (Romans 7:6)
- For Christ is the end of the Law, so that everyone exercising faith may have righteousness. (Romans 10:4)
- But their mental powers were dulled. For to this present day the same veil remains unlifted at the reading of the old covenant, because it is done away with by means of Christ. (2 Corinthians 3:14)

- The purpose was that the blessing of Abraham might come to be by means of Jesus Christ for the nations, that we might receive the promised spirit through our faith. (Galatians 3:14)
- And blotted out the handwritten document against us, which consisted of decrees and which was in opposition to us, and He has taken it out of the way by nailing it to the torture stake. (Colossians 2:14)
- If you died together with Christ toward the elementary things of the world, why do you, as if living in the world, further subject yourselves to the decrees. (Colossians 2:20)
- Also, let the peace of the Christ control in Your hearts, for You were, in fact, called to it in one body. And show yourselves thankful. (Colossians 3:15)
