Ephesians 2:5. Made us alive together with the Christ, even when we were dead in trespasses, by undeserved kindness you have been saved.

- Furthermore, though you were dead in your trespasses and in the uncircumcised state of your flesh, God made you alive together with him. He kindly forgave us all our trespasses (Colossians 2:13)
- Because the Law was given through Moses, the undeserved kindness and the truth came to be through Jesus Christ. (John 1:17)
- Because this my son was dead and came to life again, he was lost and was found. And they started to enjoy themselves. (Luke 15:24)
- For, indeed, Christ, while we were yet weak, died for ungodly men at the appointed time. (Romans 5:6)
- If, now, the spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in You, he that raised up Christ Jesus from the dead will also make Your mortal bodies alive through his spirit that resides in You. (Romans 8:11)
- Wherefore he says; Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and the Christ will shine upon you. (Ephesians 5:14)
- He saved us and called us with a holy calling, not by reason of our works, but by reason of his own purpose and undeserved kindness. This was given us in connection with Christ Jesus before times long lasting. (2 Timothy 1:9)
