- Furthermore, though **YOU** were **dead** in **YOUR** **trespasses** and in the uncircumcised state of **YOUR** flesh, God made **YOU** **alive together** with him. He kindly forgave us all our **trespasses** (**Colossians 2:13**)
- Because the Law was given through Moses, the **undeserved kindness** and the truth came to be through Jesus **Christ**. (**John 1:17**)
- Because this my son was **dead** and came to life again, he was lost and was found. And they started to enjoy themselves. (**Luke 15:24**)
- For, indeed, **Christ**, while we were yet weak, died for ungodly men at the appointed time. (**Romans 5:6**)
- If, now, the spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the **dead** dwells in **YOU**, he that raised up **Christ** Jesus from the **dead** will also make **YOUR** mortal bodies **alive** through his spirit that resides in **YOU**. (**Romans 8:11**)
- Wherefore he says; Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the **dead**, and the **Christ** will shine upon you. (**Ephesians 5:14**)
- He **saved** us and called us with a holy calling, not by reason of our works, but by reason of his own purpose and **undeserved kindness**. This was given us in connection with **Christ** Jesus before times long lasting. (**2 Timothy 1:9**)
