Ephesians 3:17. To have the Christ dwell through your faith in your hearts with love, that you may be rooted and established on the foundation.

- In answer Jesus said to him; If anyone loves me, he will observe my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him and make our abode with him. (John 14:23)
- Rooted and being built up in him and being stabilized in the faith, just as you were taught, overflowing with faith in thanksgiving. (Colossians 2:7)
- Provided, of course, that you continue in the faith, established on the foundation and steadfast and not being shifted away from the hope of that Good News which you heard, and which was preached in all creation that is under heaven. Of this Good News I Paul became a minister. (Colossians 1:23)
- No man will be firmly established by wickedness, but as for the root-foundation of the righteous ones, it will not be caused to stagger. (Proverbs 12:3)
- And I have made your name known to them and will make it known, in order that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in union with them. (John 17:26)
- To whom God has been pleased to make known what are the glorious riches of this sacred secret among the nations. It is Christ in union with YOU, the hope of his glory. (Colossians 1:27)
