Ephesians 3:6" Namely, that people of the nations should be joint heirs and fellow members of the body and partakers with us of the promise in union with Christ Jesus through the Good News.

- And that he might fully reconcile both peoples in one body to God through the torture stake, because he had killed off the enmity by means of himself. (Ephesians 2:16)
- And, look! I am sending forth upon you that which is promised by my Father. You, though, abide in the city until you become clothed with power from on high. (Luke 24:49)
- But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit arrives upon you, and you will be witnesses of me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the most distant part of the earth. (Acts of Apostles 1:8)
- The purpose was that the blessing of Abraham might come to be by means of Jesus Christ for the nations, that we might receive the promised spirit through our faith. (Galatians 3:14)
- And not for the nation only, but in order that the children of God who are scattered about he might also gather together in one. (John 11:52)
- And he said to them; You well know how unlawful it is for a Jew to join himself to or approach a man of another race, and yet God has shown me I should call no man defiled or unclean. (Acts of Apostles 10:28)
- Namely, us, whom he called not only from among Jews but also from among nations, what of it? (Romans 9:24)
- In union with whom we were also assigned as heirs, in that we were foreordained according to the purpose of him who operates all things according to the way his will counsels. (Ephesians 1:11)
- This sacred secret is great. Now I am speaking with respect to Christ and the congregation. (Ephesians 5:32)

- To whom God has been pleased to make known what are the glorious riches of this sacred secret among the nations. It is Christ in union with YOU, the hope of his glory. (Colossians 1:27)
- That their hearts may be comforted, that they may be harmoniously joined together in love and with a view to all the riches of the full assurance of their understanding, with a view to an accurate knowledge of the sacred secret of God, namely, Christ. (Colossians 2:2)
- Holding the sacred secret of the faith with a clean conscience. (1 Timothy 3:9)
- For we actually become partakers of the Christ only if we make fast our hold on the confidence we had at the beginning firm to the end. (Hebrews 3:14)
