- The names of the twelve **apostles** are these, first, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of Zebedee and John his brother. (**Matthew 10:2**)
- And God has set the respective ones in the congregation, first, **apostles**, second, **prophets**, third, **teachers**, then powerful works, then gifts of healings, helpful services, abilities to direct, different tongues. (**1 Corinthians 12:28**)
- The next day we set out and arrived in Caesarea, and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelizer, who was one of the seven men, and we stayed with him. (**Acts of Apostles 21:8**)
- Now in Antioch there were **prophets** and **teachers** in the local congregation, Barnabas as well as Symeon who was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen who was educated with Herod the district ruler, and Saul. (**Acts of Apostles 13:1**)
- Not many of **you** should become **teachers**, my brothers, knowing that we shall receive heavier judgment. (**James 3:1**)
- You have ascended on high; You have carried away captives; You have taken gifts in the form of men, yes, even the stubborn ones, to reside among them, O Yah God. (**Psalms 68:18**)
- Upon your walls, O Jerusalem, I have commissioned watchmen. All day long and all night long, constantly, let them not keep still. **You** who are making mention of Yehowah, let there be no silence on **YOUR** part. (**Isaiah 62:6**)
- And I will give **you** **shepherds** in agreement with my heart, and they will certainly feed **you** with knowledge and insight. (**Jeremiah 3:15**)
- Now in these days **prophets** came down from Jerusalem to Antioch. (**Acts of Apostles 11:27**)

- **Pay attention to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has appointed **you** overseers, to shepherd the congregation of God, which he purchased with the blood of his own Son. (**Acts of Apostles 20:28**)**
- **And there are varieties of ministries, and yet there is the same Lord. (**1 Corinthians 12:5**)**
- **Further, let two or three **prophets** speak, and let the others discern the meaning. (**1 Corinthians 14:29**)**
- **Wherefore he says; When he ascended on high he carried away captives, he gave gifts in men. (**Ephesians 4:8**)**
- **For, indeed, although **you** ought to be **teachers** in view of the time, **you** again need someone to teach **you** from the beginning the elementary things of the sacred pronouncements of God, and **you** have become such as need milk, not solid food. (**Hebrews 5:12**)**
