Ephesians 4:11... And he gave some as apostles, some as prophets, some as evangelizers, 1 some as shepherds and teachers.

- The names of the twelve apostles are these, first, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of Zebedee and John his brother. (Matthew 10:2)
- And God has set the respective ones in the congregation, first, apostles, second, prophets, third, teachers, then powerful works, then gifts of healings, helpful services, abilities to direct, different tongues. (1 Corinthians 12:28)
- The next day we set out and arrived in Caesarea, and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelizer, who was one of the seven men, and we stayed with him. (Acts of Apostles 21:8)
- Now in Antioch there were prophets and teachers in the local congregation, Barnabas as well as Symeon who was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen who was educated with Herod the district ruler, and Saul. (Acts of Apostles 13:1)
- Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, knowing that we shall receive heavier judgment. (James 3:1)
- You have ascended on high; You have carried away captives; You have taken gifts in the form of men, yes, even the stubborn ones, to reside among them, O Yah God. (Psalms 68:18)
- Upon your walls, O Jerusalem, I have commissioned watchmen. All day long and all night long, constantly, let them not keep still. You who are making mention of Yehowah, let there be no silence on YOUR part. (Isaiah 62:6)
- And I will give you shepherds in agreement with my heart, and they will certainly feed you with knowledge and insight.

 (Jeremiah 3:15)
- Now in these days prophets came down from Jerusalem to Antioch. (Acts of Apostles 11:27)

- Pay attention to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has appointed You overseers, to shepherd the congregation of God, which he purchased with the blood of his own Son. (Acts of Apostles 20:28)
- And there are varieties of ministries, and yet there is the same Lord. (1 Corinthians 12:5)
- Further, let two or three prophets speak, and let the others discern the meaning. (1 Corinthians 14:29)
- Wherefore he says; When he ascended on high he carried away captives, he gave gifts in men. (Ephesians 4:8)
- For, indeed, although you ought to be teachers in view of the time, you again need someone to teach you from the beginning the elementary things of the sacred pronouncements of God, and you have become such as need milk, not solid food. (Hebrews 5:12)
