Ephesians 4:13" Until we all attain to the oneness in the faith and in the accurate knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of stature that belongs to the fullness of the Christ.

- Brothers, do not become young children in powers of understanding, but be babes as to badness, yet become fullgrown in powers of understanding. (1 Corinthians 14:20)
- He is the one we are publicizing, admonishing every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man complete in union with Christ. (Colossians 1:28)
- This means everlasting life, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. (John 17:3)
- Now we speak wisdom among those who are mature, but not the wisdom of this system of things nor that of the rulers of this system of things, who are to come to nothing. (1 Corinthians 2:6)
- When I was a babe, I used to speak as a babe, to think as a babe, to reason as a babe, but now that I have become a man, I have done away with the traits of a babe. (1 Corinthians 13:11)
- Why, for that matter, I do indeed also consider all things to be loss on account of the excelling value of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord. On account of him I have taken the loss of all things and I consider them as a lot of refuse, that I may gain Christ (Philippians 3:8)
- For this reason, now that we have left the primary doctrine about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying a foundation again, namely, repentance from dead works, and faith toward God. (Hebrews 6:1)
- But let endurance have its work complete, that You may be complete and sound in all respects, not lacking in anything. (James 1:4)
- Do not be afraid of the things you are about to suffer. Look! The Devil will keep on throwing some of you into prison that you may be fully put to the test, and that you may have tribulation ten

days. Prove yourself faithful even to death, and I will give you the crown of life. (Revelation 2:10)
